DEVOTIONS

About 500 years ago, the church in Europe had wandered away from God's Word. Things were being taught and said that didn't match up with the Bible. God used people, like Martin Luther, to bring the true teachings of the Bible out into the open again. Gather together all the Bibles in your home. Read Ephesians 2:8 in the different Bible versions you may have, and highlight this verse with a color marker. Choose a version of this verse to say aloud together and memorize.
