Christ the King Evangelical Lutheran Church New Foundation invites applications for regular grants, which may be made solely in support of the life and work of the Congregation and other qualified organizations whose purposes are aligned with the strategic emphases of the Church. Regular grants generally support special projects and special needs of the Congregation and its mission, as set forth in the Foundation's Grant Policies. Regular grants may not be made in support of regular operational expenses of the Congregation. All determinations made in good faith by the Board of Directors as to the character of a grant shall be conclusive.

Strong preference will be given to grant applications that, in the judgment of the Board, advance the Congregation's mission as "A Healing Place." Grant applications should describe how the proposal will benefit the Congregation and its mission, and may be submitted by December 31, 2019 to the Church office or to any member of the Foundation board (Russell Post, Kathy Collins, Bob Solberg, Wendy Wiker, and Jerry Zamzow).

Grant decisions will be announced at the Part II Annual Meeting in February 2020.
